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#### **Definitions**

- "Number of Students Who Began the Program" means the number of students who began a program who were scheduled to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year and excludes all students who cancelled during the cancellation period.
- "Students Available for Graduation" is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.
- "Number of On-time Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year.
- "On-time Completion Rate" is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "150% Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the program length (includes on-time graduates).
- "150% Completion Rate" is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "Graduates Available for Employment" means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.
- "Graduates Unavailable for Employment" means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are
  called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing
  employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary
  institution.
- "Graduates Employed in the Field" means graduates who beginning within six months after a student completes the
  applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the
  institution has documented verification of employment. For occupations for which the state requires passing an
  examination, the six months period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination
  available after a student completes an applicable educational program.
- "Placement Rate Employed in the Field" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.
- "Number of Graduates Taking Exam" is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.
- "First Available Exam Date" is the date for the first available exam after a student completed a program.
- "Passage Rate" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who passed the exam by the number of graduates who took the reported licensing exam.
- "Number Who Passed First Available Exam" is the number of graduates who took and passed the first available licensing exam after completing the program.
- "Salary" is as reported by graduate or graduate's employer.
- "No Salary Information Reported" is the number of graduates for whom, after making reasonable attempts, the school was not able to obtain salary information.



#### STUDENTS RIGHT TO CANCEL

1. A Student has the right to cancel his or her agreement for a course of instruction, without any penalty or obligations, through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment whichever is later.

You also have the right to stop school at any time; and have the right to receive a pro rata refund if you have completed sixty (60) per cent or less of the program.

- 2. Cancellation may occur when the student provides a written notice of cancellation at the school address of your attendance, 1002 N. Broadway, Stockton, CA 95205. This can be done by mail or by hand delivery.
- 3. The written notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail properly addressed with proper postage.
- 4. The written notice of cancellation need not take any particular form and, however expressed, it is effective if it shows that the student no longer wishes to be bound by the Enrollment Agreement.
- 5. If the Enrollment Agreement is cancelled, the school will refund the student any money he/she paid, less a registration fee not to exceed \$250.00, and less any deduction for equipment not returned in good condition, within 45 days after the notice of cancellation is received.

#### STUDENT'S RIGHT TO WITHDRAW AND REFUND POLICY

1. You may withdraw from the school at any time and receive a pro rata refund if you have completed sixty (60) per cent
or less of the period of attendance. The amount of that refund is to be "pro-rated" according to the not completed portion or
the program less the cost of any equipment returned in good condition, and a registration fee not to exceed \$250.00. The
refund is to be paid within 45 days of withdrawal.

- 2. For the purpose of determining a refund under this section, a student shall be deemed to have withdrawn from a program of instruction when any of the following occurs:
- The student notifies the school of withdrawal, or as of the date of the student's withdrawal, whichever is later.
- The school terminates the student's enrollment for failure to maintain satisfactory progress; failure to abide by the school's
  rules and regulations, absence in excess of the maximum set forth by the school, and/or failure to meet financial obligations
  to the school.
- The student has failed to attend class for 3 days of the Class A Tractor Trailer Operator Program..
- Failure to return from a leave of absence.

For the purpose of determining the amount of the refund, the date of the students withdrawal shall be deemed the last date of recorded attendance. For the purpose of determining when the refund must be paid the student shall be deemed to have withdrawn at the end of 3 consecutive days of non-attendance.

If the student has received federal student financial aid funds, the student is entitled to a refund of moneys not paid from federal student financial aid program funds. If the student defaults on a federal or state loan both of the following may occur:

(1)	The federal or state government or a loan guarantee agency may take action against the student, including garnishing ar
	income tax refund; and
(2)	The student may not be eligible for any other governmental financial assistance at another institution until the loan is
	repaid.
